**15<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference on the  
Political Economy of International Organization (PEIO)**

May 4-6, 2023 – University of California, San Diego

We invite submissions for the fifteenth annual conference on the Political Economy of International Organization. The conference is hosted by UC San Diego on May 4-6, 2023. The conference brings together economists and political scientists to address political economy issues related to international organizations such as the World Trade Organization, United Nations, International Monetary Fund, World Bank, European Union, and others. We also consider submissions on topics more broadly related to international organization, such as foreign aid, international agreements and international law.

### **Submission of Papers**

Both empirical and theoretical papers will be considered. Please submit **full papers** via our online submission form at [www.peio.me](http://www.peio.me). The deadline for submission is **January 15, 2023**. We will make decisions by **February 15**.

### **Special Issue**

After the conference, presenters are encouraged to submit their papers to the *Review of International Organizations* to be considered for a special issue titled “Domestic Politics and International Organizations,” co-edited by T. Renee Bowen, J. Lawrence Broz, and Christina J. Schneider (UC San Diego). Submission to the conference does not require submitting to the special issue.

### **Conference Format, Attendance, and Registration**

The number of participants will be limited to about 100 to allow for in-depth discussion of each paper. Authors of accepted papers are expected to attend the *entire* conference. There is no conference or registration fee. Travel and accommodation are at the expense of participants.

### **Conference Venue**

The conference will be held at UC San Diego in La Jolla, California. San Diego International Airport (SAN) is 20-30 minutes from campus, by taxi or Uber. Public transportation to UC San Diego is available but requires taking the “Flyer” shuttle bus from the airport to Old Town Transit Center and then catching the new trolley.
